PROGRAM OVERVIEW



Electrical technicians help create, maintain and repair the electronic components and equipment used in any equipment or device that involves electricity. Students receive training in basic electrical wiring skills that enable them to gain entry level employment in the construction and maintenance industries. Topics include safety, mathematical applications, reading and interpreting blueprints, and direct and alternating current circuits.
