PROGRAM OVERVIEW



The Cabinetmaking diploma program is a sequence of courses that prepares students for careers in cabinetmaking and related fields. Learning opportunities develop academic, technical, and professional knowledge

and skills required for job acquisition, retention, and advancement. The program emphasizes a combination of cabinetmaking theory and practical application necessary for successful employment.

Program length is fifty-three (53) credit hours.

Cabinetmaking Assembly Technician

This certificate program prepares individuals for employment as cabinetmaking assemblers. Program completers are trained in the use of hand and power tools, cabinet design and layout, wood joints and fastening methods, and cutting cabinet components.

Program length is eleven (11) credit hours.

Cabinetmaking Installation Technician

This certificate program prepares individuals for employment as cabinetmaking assemblers and installers. Program graduates are trained in the use of hand and power tools, materials, cabinet assembly, and cabinet finishing and installation.

Program length is twelve (12) credit hours.
