

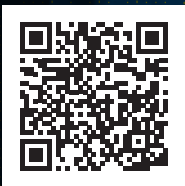

PROGRAM OVERVIEW



The Dental Assisting diploma will allow you to enter the dental field as a dental assistant and function as a chair-side

assistant or administrative assistant. As a graduate, you will be competent in the technical areas of preventive dentistry, four-handed dentistry, chair-side assisting with emphasis on diagnostics, operative field prosthodontics, pediatric dentistry, orthodontic procedures, endodontic procedures, dental practice management, and dental radiology.

Employment opportunities include: general dentistry; group practice; specific dental specialties such as oral surgery, endodontics, and orthodontics; public health dentistry; dental school clinics; and federal, state, and community clinics. Your education will also qualify you to manage a dental business office or serve in the armed forces.

Program length is fifty-five (55) credit hours.
