The Technical College System of Georgia is committed to ensuring students are academically prepared for the program's rigor. Therefore, accepted students may be assessed prior to program enrollment. Specific program placement information is listed in Attachment 6.2.1p a2.

VI. PROCEDURE:

A. Assessment of Program Readiness

1. Technical Colleges may evaluate students' readiness for the degree, diploma, and certificate programs.
2. Technical Colleges may accept one or multiple official assessment measures on the following validated assessment instruments if the scores meet the required minimums listed in Attachment 6.2.1p.a2. Program Placement Information. A student possessing an associate's degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution shall be exempted from placement requirements.
 - a. SAT
 - b. ACT/Pre-ACT
 - c. PSAT
 - d. TABE 9-10 scores of 461 or higher in Reading and 442 or higher in Math for placement into entry-level workforce certificate programs
 - e. TABE 11/12 scores of 501 in Reading for Levels M and D and 496 for Mathematics on Levels M and D. A score of 536 for Reading if using Level A and

- 537 for Mathematics if using Level A.
- f. Georgia Milestones Literature & Composition or Georgia Milestones American Literature & Composition (English admission requirement only)
 - g. High School GPA of 2.0 or higher
 - h. Approved Entry Level Workforce Certificates do not have a minimum High School GPA requirement
 - i. GED® Math or Reading must meet the minimum passing score used for placement into any certificate, diploma, or degree program
 - j. HiSET® Math, Reading, or Language Arts must meet the minimum passing score for placement into any certificate, diploma, or degree program.
 - k. Completed TCSG form documenting two years of work/career-related experience for approved Entry Level Workforce Certificates
 - l. Accuplacer/Companion
 - m. Compass/Asset
- 3. Assessment results are transferable to any TCSG College. However, each Technical College will develop its re-testing policy, and charges may apply.
 - 4. Official transcripts from a regionally or nationally accredited postsecondary institution recognized by the United States Department of Education documenting equivalent program-level English and math coursework completed may be used in place of placement exams.
 - 5. Subjective criteria such as, but not limited to, written or oral interviews, personality assessments shall not be utilized as a part of the evaluation for program readiness or admission to a college or a program. Applicants to competitive programs may optionally submit letters of reference. All criteria should be published and applied consistently to all applicants for a program.
 - 6. All students enrolled at a Technical College will be required to be placed into a program of study. The Institutionally Accepted program/major (IA00) will only be used by exception to standard program placement.

B. Placement Categories

- 1. Minimum placement requirements shall be established for each program or credential. Students shall be placed in a Technical College program of study in one of the following categories: Regular, Provisional, Special, Pending, or Transient.
 - a. Regular Status
 - i. Students who meet all requirements for placement into a selected program and are eligible to take all courses in the program curriculum are granted regular placement status.
 - b. Provisional Status
 - i. Students who meet only some requirements for regular placement into a selected program are granted provisional placement status.
 - ii. Dually or Jointly enrolled students are not eligible for Provisional placement status.

- c. Special Placement Status (Non-credential seeking)
 - i. Applicants who wish to take credit coursework but are not seeking a certificate, diploma, or associate degree are granted Special Admit status.
 - ii. The following specifics define the parameters of this status:
 - May apply up to a maximum of 25 quarter or 17 semester credit hours into a specific program for credential-seeking purposes after achieving regular admit status. The number of hours taken as a special admit student in no way waives the regular admission and placement requirements.
 - May enroll in classes only on a space-available basis.
 - Must adhere to the specific institutional prerequisite requirements when selecting courses.
 - Will not be eligible for any financial aid.
- d. Pending Placement Status (High School Seniors only)
 - i. Applicants in their final year of high school and are applying for a college term immediately after graduating are granted Pending Placement Status.
 - ii. The following specifics define the parameters of this status:
 - High school seniors may submit one of the following documents: official/unofficial transcripts, in-progress high school transcripts, 12th Grade (senior year) report card, GaDOE SLDS Report, or a letter from a high school official confirming the candidate's progress towards fulfilling all necessary high school requirements for graduation._
- e. Transient Placement Status
 - i. Students who submit a Transient Agreement from their home institution are granted Transient placement status.
 - The Transient Agreement must verify that the student is in good standing.
 - A current Transient Agreement is required for each term of enrollment.
